INCIDENT LOCATION: 113-B SHARP ST. BREMEN, GA. 30110

INCIDENT TYPE: DEATH INVESTIGATION

ON JUNE 20,2006 @ 0318HRS SGT.LEE POWELL, AND OFC. HENDERSON RECEIVED A CALL FROM DISPATCH ADVISING OF A HOUSE FIRE ON SHARP ST.. WHEN WE ARRIVED BREMEN FIRE DEPT. WAS ON THE SCENE. WE NOTICED IT WAS THE SAME DUPLEX FROM EARLYER ( WHERE SGT.POWELL, AND HENDERSON ) ANSWERED A FIGHT CALL AT 113-A SHARP ST.. WE DIDN'T SEE ANYBODY STANDING AROUND THAT LIVED AT THE DUPLEX. THE PARTY THAT WE ANSWERED A CALL WITH WASN'T AROUND. WHEN FIRE INVESTIGATOR ARRIVED, WE EXPLAINED TO HIM ABOUT THE CALL WE HAD BEFORE THE FIRE, HE TOLD DISPATCH TO GIVE OUT A BOLO ON A VEHICLE THAT BELONGED TO A MR.JUSTIN CHAPMAN. DURING THE TIME OF THE FIGHT CALL I ASKED WITNESSES FOR THEIR TELEPHONE # AND THEY GAVE ME A NUMBER. MR.CHAPMAN DIDN'T HAVE ANY TELEPHONE NUMBERS. WHILE AT THE FIRE SCENE I TOLD BREMEN DISPATCH TO CALL THE TELEPHONE NUMBER THAT WITNESSES GAVE ME, BREMEN DISPATCH ADVISED IT WAS NOLONGER IN SERVICE. AT 0500HRS MR.CHAPMAN PULLED UP TO THE FIRE SCENE ASKING IF MS.ALICA WAS INSIDE OF THE RESIDENCE. SGT.POWELL, AND MYSELF GOT HIM OFF TO THE SIDE AND TOLD HIM TO WAIT FOR INV.ATTISON, AND STATE FIRE INVESTIGATOR. MR.CHAPMAN STATED HE HAD A BAD FEELING ABOUT SOMETHING WAS WRONG. INVESTIGATORS TOLD HIM TO FOLLOW ME TO BREMEN POLICE DEPT. TO WRITEOUT A STATEMENT. HE ASKED IF HE COULD GO AND GET HIS WIFE SINCE SHE COULD WRITE. THE INVESTIGATORS AGREED TO BUT TOLD ME TO FOLLOW HIM SINCE HIS WIFE WAS STAYING WITH THEIR FRIENDS HOUSE AT LIGHTHOUSE CHURCH ( MOBILE HOME PARK ). MR.CHAPMAN STOPPED AT HIS AUNTS HOUSE RIGHT UP THE STREET(SHARP ST.) TO DROP OFF HIS CHILDREN. FROM THERE WE WENT TO BREMEN POLICE DEPT. TO PICK UP OFC. MCINTYRE. THEN WE FOLLOW HIM TO THE MOBILE HOME PARK. WHEN WE ARRIVED WE FOLLOW HIM TO THE TRAILER WE WALKED INTO THE TRAILER, HE TOLD HIS WIFE. I TOLD HER AND THE TWO WITNESSES I NEEDED THEM TO COME TO THE POLICE DEPT. TO WRITEOUT A STATEMENTS. THEN MR. CHAPMAN TOLD HIS WIFE WE STILL HAVE MOVIES AND OUR PLAYSTATION. WE ESCORTED THEM TO BREMEN POLICE DEPT. I HAD THEM TO WRITEOUT STATEMENTS, EXCEPT STEPHEN HUGHES, HE ADVISED HE COULDN'T READ OR WRITE.
